Since beginning these annual cruises, the Mens Club has generated between \$50 and 60 thousand dollars which is used to support our Lifeline Medical Alert System program and other community sponsorships. The funds raised on these cruises come from money earned based on the number of cabins booked, and by a sharing of income from Travelworld! Nothing is added to the cost of each cabin...prices are those received by Travelworld from the cruise lines . If a lower price is seen as available from another source for a specific cruise, investigate it with Travelworld. Some offers elsewhere can be misleading.

The Mens Club plans at least one fundraising cruise each year...open to members, friends, neighbors, family, and acquaintances! The cruises are planned and organized with SCC Travelworld who handles the bookings and other details. In almost all cases, a bus or buses are provided to take our group to the appropriate port, and return after the cruise. Each of our cruisers select their cabin, their activities and excursions on board, and their dining preferences. Often, most of our cruisers select early dining and the group dines in close proximity. A group cocktail party is held early on each cruise and a group casino event for those who wish to participate.




